

Camp Mohawk Facilities.

During your visit to Camp Mohawk you will have many facilities for the whole family to enjoy.

- First aid hut – a fully equipped first aid centre to take care of your medical needs.
- Special Care Block – which contains specialist multi-sensory rooms – the White room to relax in, the Dark room for stimulation.
- Quiet Room – (or Shhhhhh room) where you can sit, read, draw or play games, with TV, video and music centre for wet days.
- Ball Pool.
- Barbecues.
- Swimming Pool – with beach type approach either end. Maximum depth 1meter with all weather dome. Qualified lifeguards (where possible),
- Main Hall – has catering facilities and indoor dining area.
- Toilet Block – four bathroom suites, each of which have a bath, shower, toilet, hand basin and changing bench.
- Woodland walks in 168 acre forest.

New for this year

Camp Mohawk is hoping to add a few extra areas of improvement that have been suggested by members of Camp Mohawk.

- Pathways – there will be a number of pathways for wheelchair bound people to allow them access to all Camp Mohawk's indoor and outdoor facilities.
- Small play and picnic area – to provide a safe play environment for the younger children within this there will be swings, slide and climbing frame as well as a few picnic tables.
