

Have your say about changes we're making in adult social care

There are now more than 500 people in the Wokingham borough receiving a personal budget from the Council. The new system of self-directed support means that, as a Council, we have to adapt the way in which we work. We cannot carry on as we are currently organised and provide the best service to you, so we need to make changes to the way we work - **this may affect you.**

Whether you receive a personal budget, receive other adult social care services, provide a service, or care for someone, **we would like your opinion** on the important changes we are making to how we work and are organised, so that personal budgets can be made available to more and more people.
