



Aiming High trip to **Reading** **vs.** **West Ham United**

Saturday December 10th, 2011



This activity is specifically for Children and Young People living in Bracknell Forest with:

- *Physical disabilities and/or complex health needs*
- *ASD and severe learning disabilities or challenging behaviour*
- *Challenging behaviour associated with other impairments such as severe learning disability*

We will be providing transport from Bracknell town centre, leaving at around 1pm. The match starts at 3pm and we should be back by 6pm. There will be time for a Reading Shop visit prior to the match starting. We can also provide transport for families with wheelchairs.

Aiming High will pay for tickets for children meeting the criteria, an adult carer for each disabled child and one other child in your family group. If you would like to bring any other people with you, tickets can be purchased at £7.50 for a child, £20 for an adult. Transport will be free of charge and provided by Aiming High, although you can of course make your own way to the stadium if you prefer.

It is a requirement of Reading FC that you fill out a disabled persons registration form and provide a copy of your DLA. We will only be able to book your seats if you meet the criteria and we are in receipt of this documentation.

Please register your interest now so that we can book adequate spaces. Booking and registration forms will be sent out in November.
