## **New Forest Activity Weekend For 12-18 year olds**

Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March to Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012.

Kids have now completed 3 very successful weekends for young people and there will be one more this term, from Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March to Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012.

The weekend will provide various activity opportunities such as adventure course, archery, high ropes etc) and young people will be expected to develop independence skills by shopping, cooking and taking some overall responsibility for themselves.

**This activity is strictly for young people meeting the criteria below and who live in Bracknell Forest only.**

It is anticipated that young people will:

- Have moderate learning difficulties;
- Have a Statement, be on School Action or School Action Plus eg have a special educational need;
- Require low level and minimal supervision;
- Be able to communicate in small group settings

**Places offered for the weekend will be subject to a full risk assessment. Where the young person is not known to Kids, a home visit may be required.**

Aiming High will subsidise the significant cost of these trips. **The cost of the trip to parents will be £50 per child.**

**Places will be considered on a first come, first served basis and priority will be given to young people who have not attended this trip before and who are not currently receiving other overnight opportunities through Children's Social Care.**
