This is one of the UK's most popular Christmas Markets which will have approximately 90 wooden chalets selling a wide range of gifts, and crafts as well as a festive food court, a Nativity Scene, a Father Christmas Ice Cave (grotto) and a beautiful Christmas tree all of which surround a large open-air real ice rink. As well as the Christmas Market, Winchester has many independent shops and boutiques in its compact pedestrian friendly centre. If you prefer to do something other than shopping you could visit the Cathedral where Jane Austen's tomb can be found, the Great Hall and King Arthur's round table or The Military Museum to name just a few.

This trip is open to carers, their families and friends; places will be allocated on a first come first basis. The coach will leave from Wokingham at 9.30am and will leave Winchester at 4.30pm, returning to Wokingham at approximately 6.00pm. Ticket prices are £10 per person.
